Application Guidelines for 2022 Kyushu University Fund Study Abroad Scholarship (Travel Support Program)

1. Purpose

Kyushu University Fund Study Abroad Scholarship (Travel Support Program) was established to support students to acquire intercultural awareness and global perspectives through studying abroad experiences. Students are expected to improve initiative skills and also to hone their skills in other various fields such as language, communication and presentation.

2. Eligibility

Applicants must be full-time students at Kyushu University who will participate in one of the following study abroad programs.

- 1) Student Exchange Program (both University-wide and Faculty/Graduate School levels)
- 2) Double Degree Program
- * Those who have received support for travel expenses from other funds are not eligible for this program.

3. Study Period

- Applicants must participate in a program for more than 3 months (93 days) but less than 1 year (365 days) except for Double Degree Program.
- Program must begin between April 1, 2022 and March 31, 2023.

5. Applications

Complete the following online form (Microsoft Forms) and upload the required documents within the application period. Late submission and incomplete application will not be accepted.

- Transcripts
 - -Undergraduates: most recent transcript
 - -Graduates: most recent transcript AND final transcript from Undergraduate
- · Certificate of proficiency in the language used at the host university
- Letter of Acceptance (If not obtained at the time of application, upload a document that proves the study period such as a screenshot of the academic calendar of the host university. LoA must be submitted as soon as it arrives.
- *Applications are accepted before and during the study abroad program.
- *Selection results will be announced in the month following the deadline.
- * If budget permits, additional applications may be accepted around October.

6. Selection

Selection of the candidate will be made by Selection Committee of the International Exchange Students (Overseas Study Program).

7. Payment

A scholarship awardee will receive a once-off payment after the study abroad program is started. To prove the start of the program, electronically submit a copy of the boarding pass or the entry page with an arrival stamp within one week of traveling.

8. Responsibilities

Scholarship awardees must submit the following documents within one month of returning to Japan.

- Accomplishment Report (designated form)
- A copy of the boarding pass for return flight or the entry page with a departure stamp

9. Important Notes

- (1)Scholarship may be used to cover the cost of travel and preparation for the trip
- (2) Those who fail to fulfill aforementioned "8. Responsibilities" will be asked to return the grant.
- (3) Recipients must use Fukuoka Airport as a departure and arrival airport. Stopovers are not permitted except for connection flight.
- (4) The date of departure and return should be within two weeks of the start and end of the study period indicated in the Letter of Acceptance.
- (5) Travel cost for participating in an internship program or academic conference is not supported by this program.
- (6) Changing the host university after the application is not permitted.
- (7) Students are not able to receive this scholarship for two consecutive fiscal years. Check beforehand if you are eligible to apply for this program.
- (8) The name of the recipient, department, academic year, and the content of the accomplishment report will be published on the university website and other sources.
- (9) Travel Support Program can be awarded in conjunction with the following scholarship(s).
